



Priority 1 - Using data to identify and target support

Improving writing pedagogy & attainment, using BGE tool and tracking information for early identification of pupils.

- Teachers will create clear writing plans for each year group (P1–P7), using ideas from Stephen Graham and Talk for Writing to support learning.
- Staff will work together to agree on clear examples of high-quality writing for each stage, so pupils understand what successful writing looks like.
- Staff will visit other schools and take part in peer reviews to learn from successful writing approaches.
- Park View Primary will have a strong, well-structured Writing Programme and Policy that reflects best practice and supports high standards in writing.

Priority 2- IDL (Interdisciplinary Learning)

Enhancing curriculum through the development of skills and tracking wider achievements and skills.

- Staff will continue to develop their understanding of how to build important skills into everyday learning, ensuring this aligns with South Lanarkshire Council's curriculum principles.
- Parents will have more opportunities to hear about and celebrate the skills and achievements pupils are developing across the school.
- Pupils will enjoy a wider range of learning experiences beyond the classroom, helping them to build new skills in different settings.

Priority 3 - Health & Wellbeing

Implementing refreshed whole school Health & Wellbeing curriculum and developing whole school approach to emotional regulation

- Staff will take part in training to help pupils manage their emotions and promote positive wellbeing across the school.
- All teachers will use the new Park View Health & Wellbeing Planners to support pupils' health and emotional development.
- Programmes like Buddy Training will help pupils, especially in P1 and P7, learn strategies for building friendships and managing emotions.
- Park View will have a refreshed Health & Wellbeing Policy that supports pupils' social and emotional wellbeing and helps parents feel confident supporting their children at home.
